



Registration Information – Spring 2012

Forms:

Registrations are processed on a first come first served basis. Registrations must be complete, including all payments, to be accepted. All forms can be completed on your computer and printed out. If completed on your computer, the total payable will be automatically calculated at the bottom of the form. Highlighted session costs include applicable coaching fees. Write cheques as specified in the blue box at the bottom of the form. All cheques must be made payable to The Vancouver Skating Club.

Skating Qualifications:

Competitive A: Skaters who have passed the Pre-Novice competitive test or higher.

Competitive B: Skaters who have passed the Preliminary free skate test up to the Sr. Bronze free skate test or the Juvenile competitive test. Special permission may be granted based on previous placement to Comp B sessions. Please consult with your coach and the Competitive Skating Director.

Pre Competitive: Skaters who have not passed any Skate Canada free skate test.

Pre Competitive Bridgers: Pre Comp skaters by coach's invitation.

The Competitive Skating Director along with the coaching staff will designate skaters to the appropriate levels. Skaters may be moved between levels based on ice availability and tests passed. All requests to move skaters must be in writing from the requesting coach to Tina Leininger, Competitive Skating Director.

Payment Information:

Registration received after February 27, 2012 will incur an additional 10% late fee. Skaters with registrations that total over \$500 may choose to pay in three equal installments. Installment dates and payment information are included on the individual registration forms. Any person having issued two or more returned cheques must make all subsequent payments to the Club by cash, certified cheque, or money order.
